



DEATHS.
In this town, on Saturday, Mrs. Mary, widow of the late Mr. Samuel Nutting, aged 34.
On Sunday departed this life, PAUL REVERE, Esq. in the 84th year of his age. During his protracted life, his activity in business and benevolence, the vigor of his mind, and strength of his constitution were unabated. He was one of the earliest and most indefatigable Patriots and Soldiers of the Revolution, and has filled with fidelity, ability and usefulness, many important situations in the military and civil service of his country, and at the head of valued and benignant institutions. Seldom has the tomb closed upon a life so honorable and useful.
